

PRIVACY POLICY

The Indiana Podiatric Medical Association respects your privacy. We do not collect any personal information via our web site.

Unless you call or email us and identify yourself to us, we have no idea who you are. Even then, all communications are confidential.

Cookies

Cookies on this system are not used for collecting any personal information. They are merely used to make it easier for you to login and access pages.

Web Logs

Our web server may collect standard aggregate data called "web log" information such as your web browser, operating system, and pages visited. For example, when you visit one of our web sites, our web server will automatically recognize some non-personal information, including but not limited to the date and time you visited our site, the pages you visited, the referrer (the website you came from), the type/version of browser you are using, the type of operating system you are using (e.g., Windows '95 or Mac OS), and the domain name and address of your Internet service provider (e.g., America Online, EarthLink).

Our web log does not collect any personal information. It does not contain personal information such as your name or email address.

Security

Our web log information (such as your web browser, operating system, pages visited, etc.) is used to help us design our website and to identify our most popular pages. However, web logs may be used if necessary to help identify any person attempting to break into or damage our web site. We may share web log information with law enforcement agencies if we believe that we have evidence of a violation of computer security or related laws.
